

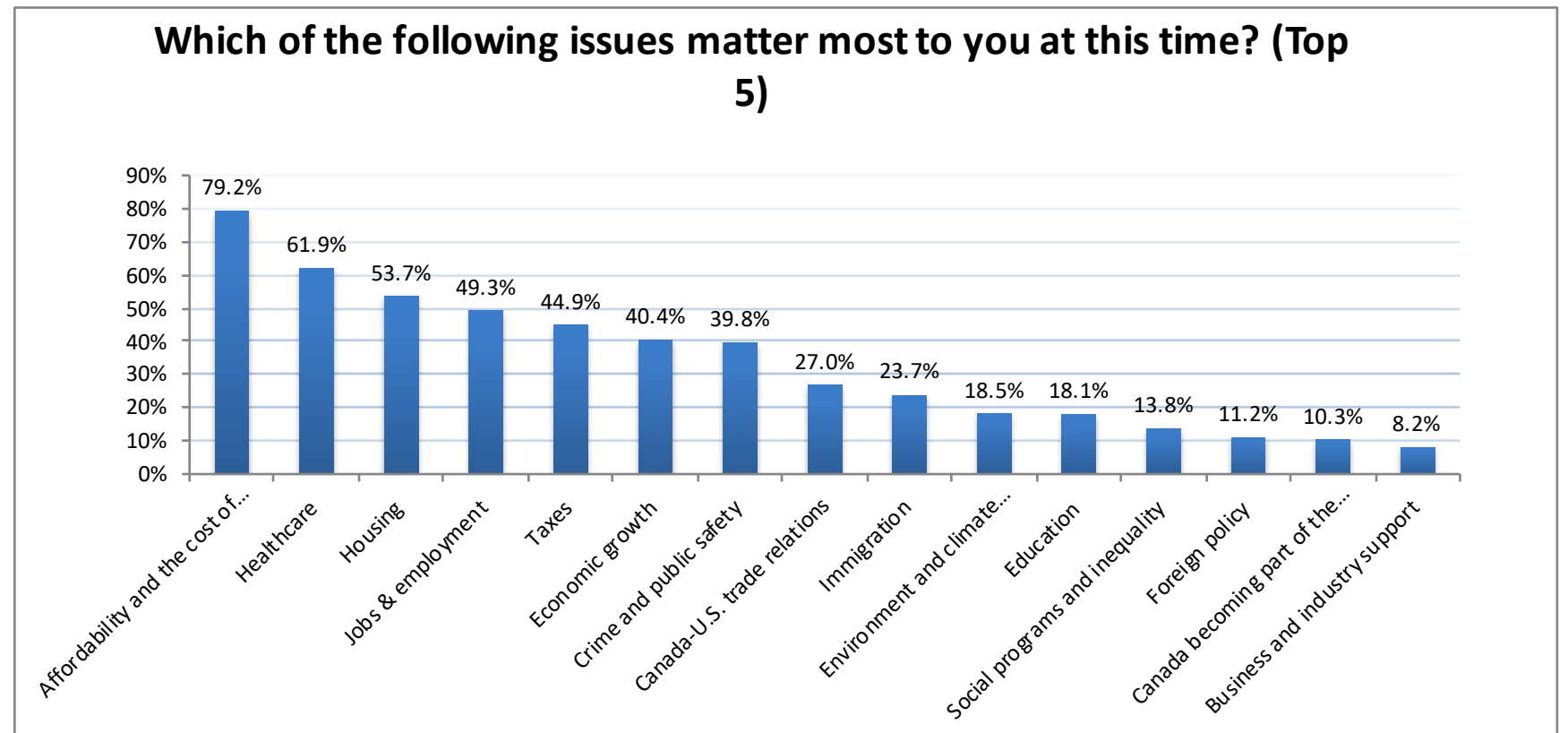

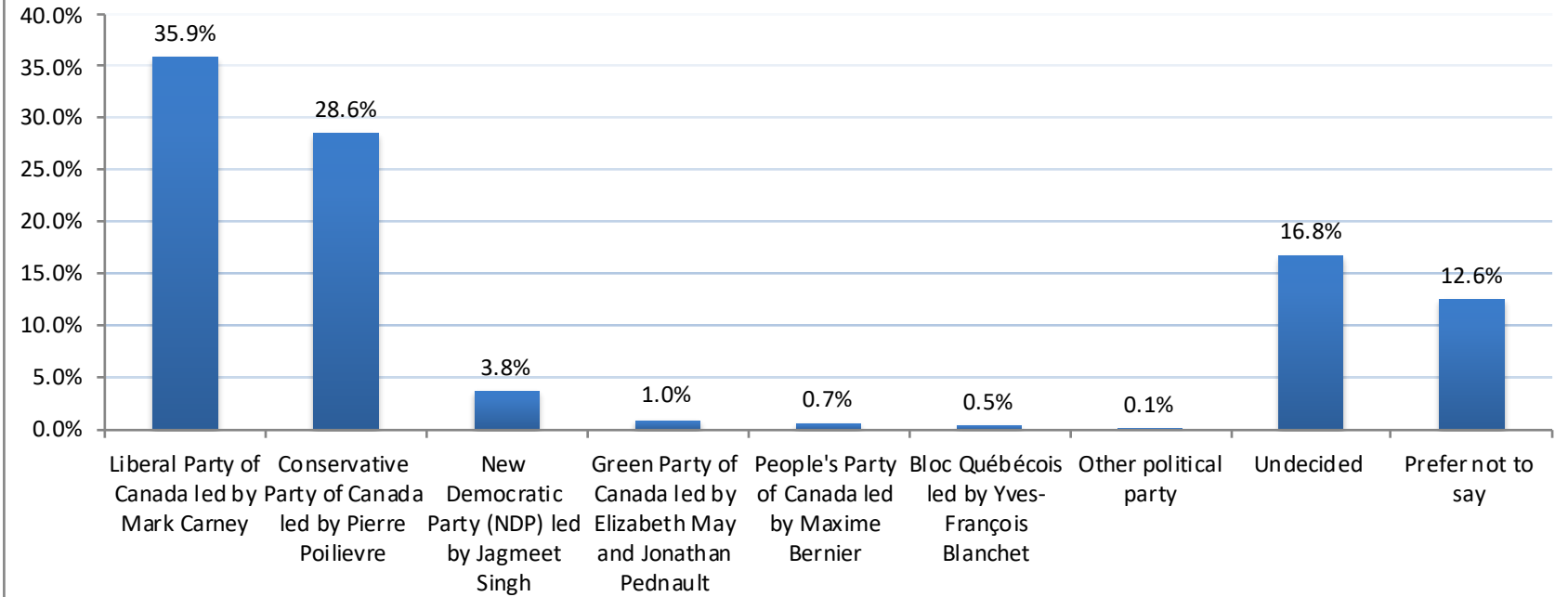

If the federal election were held today, which party would you vote for?

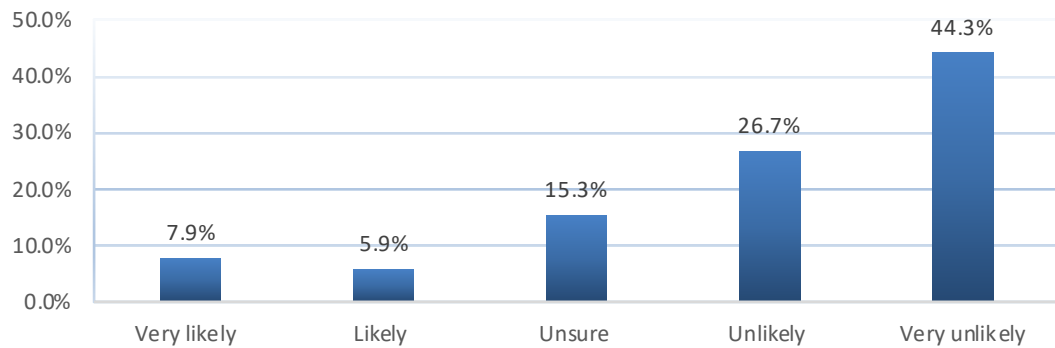


How likely are you to change your intention to vote for the [Preferred Party] between now and election day on April 28th, 2025?

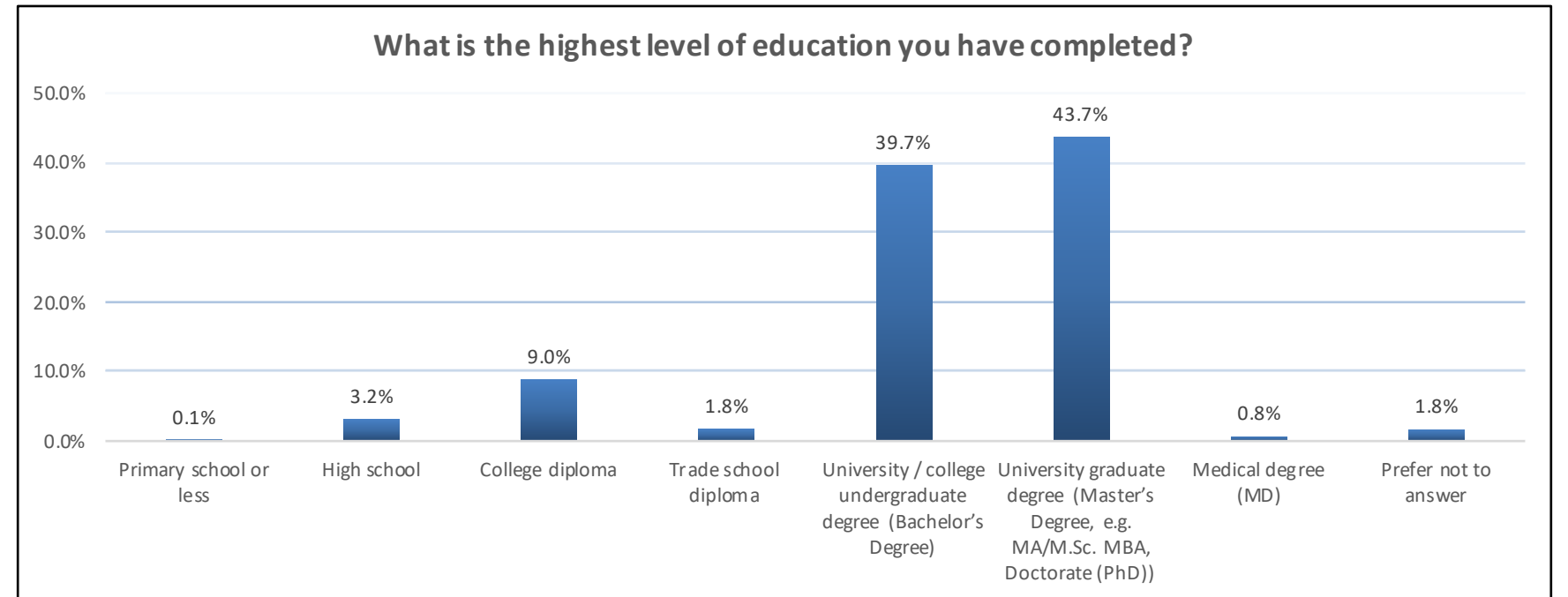
How likely are you to change your intention to vote for the [Preferred Party] between now and election day on April 28th, 2025?

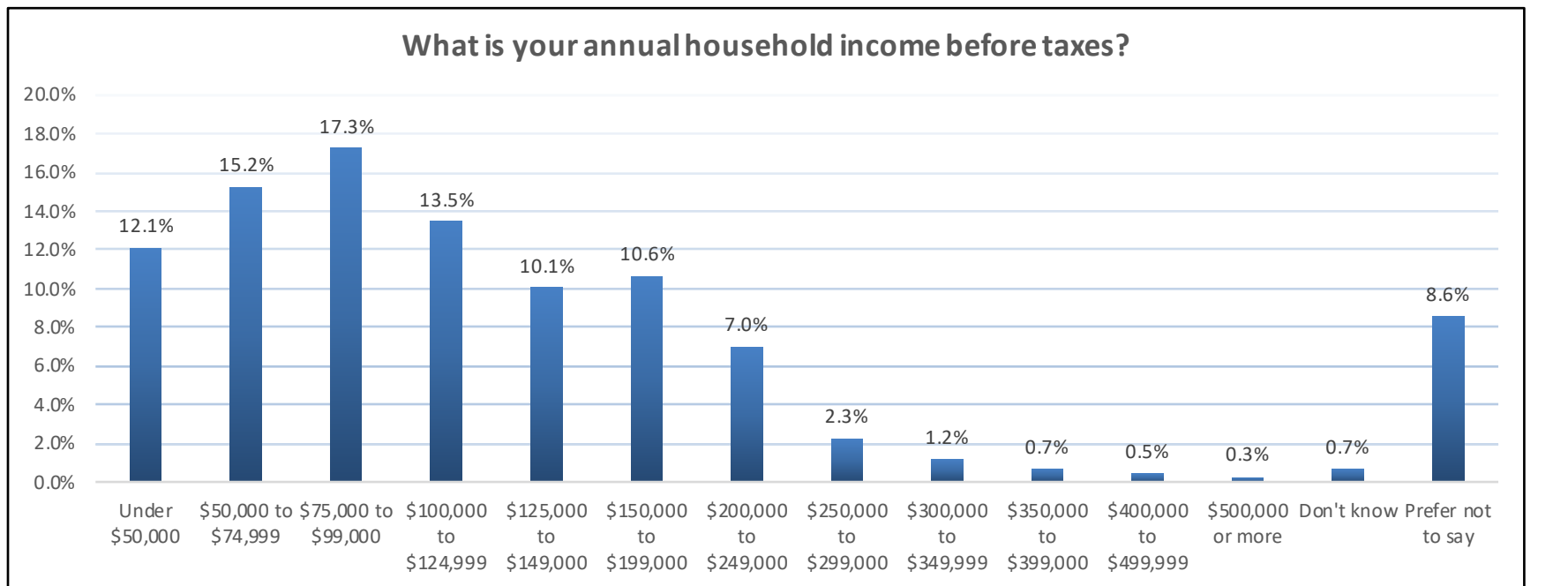
